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## Pre-Anesthetic Checklist

Please review the checklist below and follow the listed directions:

- Remove all food after 8:00 p.m. the night before your pet's procedure.
- Remove water the morning of your pet's procedure.
- Complete and sign the pre-anesthetic testing/surgery release and estimate forms.
- Give lots of extra hugs and kisses!

All surgery patients at Companion Pet Care are closely monitored with state-of-the-art instrumentation, including Computerized Electrocardiogram and Blood Pressure Machines, and with Pulse Oximetry, which monitors and measures the oxygen carried in the blood. These technologies, along with pre-anesthetic screening, reduce the risk of anesthesia to its lowest level. In addition, your pet will receive a pain relief injection to minimize any discomfort that might be experienced following surgery.

If you have any questions regarding pre-anesthetic blood testing, or of your pet's upcoming procedure, please don't hesitate to call.

Your pet is scheduled for a procedure that requires anesthesia. For pets 2 years of age or older, we require baseline blood work to ensure that your pet is in a low-risk category prior to anesthesia. The latest technology has enabled us to run safe and accurate blood chemistries minutes before anesthetic induction. The cost of the baseline blood work is included in the price of your pet's surgical procedure estimate.

These tests are similar to and equally as important as those your own physician would run if you were to undergo anesthesia. In addition, the results of these tests will serve as reference values for future use, should your pet become ill. Please check one of the following pre-anesthetic testing profiles.

\_\_\_\_ PROFILE A:      **Baseline Profile**  
Cost: \$60 (Included in estimate)      This profile is required prior to any anesthetic procedure and assesses anemia and hydration, and evaluates kidney function, blood sugar, and liver function.

\_\_\_\_ PROFILE B:      **A Complete Patient Health Assessment**  
Additional Cost: \$90      Optional for healthy patients in this age group, unless there are specific health concerns. *Strongly recommended for patients over 7 years of age.* Includes all components of Profile A, plus will evaluate clotting ability, presence of infection, cancer indicators, and pancreatic disorders.
